BAHA Student Expectations Agreement

BAHA operates on a system of respect. Whether it is directed from one student to another, toward the facility we use, in the classroom towards the teacher, or in the classroom with effort and attitude; Each student must agree to the following list of expectations and guidelines in order to be a part of the BAHA program. If at any time one or more of this checklist is violated, BAHA will take correctional and disciplinary measures, that if not resolved, could ultimately result in the student no longer being able to participate in BAHA classes. Please read the following carefully, initial and sign. _I understand that at BAHAI am expected to participate in my classes; this includes turning assignments in, being prepared for class, and having an overall positive and engaging attitude in the classroom. _ I understand that my words and actions while at BAHA need to be kind and respectful. This includes how I speak to other students, how I speak to teachers, and how I speak to Study Hall Supervisors. No threatening or inappropriate conversations are permitted. No bullying of any kind will be tolerated. I understand that I need to respect the property of others including the facility of Trinity Fellowship Church. This means, I need to pick up after myself trying to always leave the place I was sitting better than when I found it. No writing on walls or tables, no rough housing, no standing or walking on items not intended for that purpose, no vandalism of any kind. I understand that weapons of any kind, including pocketknives, are not allowed on campus. I also understand that talking about weapons, even as a joke, is not appropriate and will not be allowed. I understand that my clothes need to be appropriate and in line with the BAHA standards of dress code: No skirts, dresses, or shorts that are above finger-tip length; No hole-y jeans with holes above finger-tip length. Spaghetti or think strap tank tops. cropped tops exposing mid-drift, and low cut or tight fitted shirts for girls are not allowed. Any clothing, bags, or other items with vulgar or violent images or messages that do not align with BAHA standard and statement of faith on them are not allowed. Shoes are required in class and in Study Hall. I understand that cell phones and other electronics are **NOT** permitted in class or study hall unless they are being used with permission for academic reasons or to communicate with a parent/carpool. This includes

cellphones, air pods, Nintendo Switches, laptops, kindles, iPads, headphones, etc. I also understand that my phone/device may be taken up by teachers or supervisors if I have it out and am not honoring the electronics

policy and will only be returned with a parent present.

I understand that I am to wear my ID around my neck at all times when on campus.
I understand that I am to be in class or study hall at all times; I know that loitering around the facility and parking lot is not permitted.
I understand that I must sign in and sign out when I come and go on campus; and that I may not leave campus without my parent's permission form on file.
I understand that I am not allowed to sit in any BAHA class that I am not enrolled in and I am not allowed to bring friends or any non-BAHA student with me to BAHA.
I understand that the use of Uber, Uber Eats, or DoorDash, or any other similar services are NOT permitted.
I understand that absolutely no illegal substance of any kind will be permitted on BAHA campus including, but not limited to alcohol, drugs, vape pens, and any form of prescription drugs that don't belong to me. I also understand that coming to class "under the influence" of anything illegal is not permitted and will not be tolerated.
I understand that PDA (public display of affection) is not permitted on campus. All students regardless of gender or relationship status (friends or more than friends) should keep their hands to themselves at all times, Students may not share seats in class or study hall but need to be seated separately in his/her own chair. Sexual misconduct of any kind will result in immediate dismissal from the program.
I understand that my personal character matters, and that I need to be a student of integrity on campus and off campus. I also understand that certain decisions and actions I make off campus or on social media can affect my eligibility to participate in BAHA.
